Bogle vineyards petite syrah is my favorite wine. Daughter Susan found this and I now order it by the case. Beware of the "experts" telling you what you're going to taste with any wine. In a previous life, I started the first website selling wine directly to the consumer. I frequently bumped heads with wine "experts" and confronted them with their regal pronouncements about what I would taste. I told them I'm old, have smoked a pipe for over 50 years and my tongue must be like leather by now. Then I challenged them to a blind wine tasting using a cheap wine against the high dollar wine of the same **varietal**...that's the **grape** it comes from. Most of them backed off and agreed taste is personal. You can do your own search...the syrah grape is twice the size of the petite syrah grape and I think it dilutes the taste while the petite is heavier...when I taste it. That's red wine. Try this for white wine if you like sweet. Look for late harvest Riesling. The first frost forces more sugar out of the grape. The advantage of wine: doesn't anesthetize your tongue so you'll taste the last drop just before you fall asleep (*pass out*).


