



### Recipe Corner

Some of my **1%ers\*** joined me for a pizza event. The wives got wine while the guys got spoons and coaching on how to make the crust. These guys are genius in a garage but (*confirmed by their wives*) totally lost in the kitchen. The event did allow me to experiment with Dan Rocco's Italian grandmother's recipe:

#### Ingredients

- 4 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 tablespoon yeast
- 3/4 cup white wine
- 2 TBS extra-virgin olive oil
- 1 tsp salt
- 2 cups lukewarm water

#### Directions

Mound the flour in a large bowl and create a well in the middle of the flour. Add yeast to the well, along with the white wine, olive oil and a portion of salted lukewarm water. Work the flour slowly, adding the rest of the salted lukewarm water as needed until it turns into a uniform dough. Cover the dough and let rest to rise for about 20 to 30 minutes at room temp.

*(I bake the crust @ 450 F before adding the sauce, meat and cheese. ...then back into the hot oven. I have some special pizza tools and pans but not required.)*

*(See how that works?).*




### Book Report

Good luck with that argument...as of 2018, the Supreme Court had overruled more than 300 of its own cases. Some were hilarious when using common sense.


